

TOURIST INFORMATION OF CANCÚN, QUINTANA ROO.

Located on the Yucatán Peninsula, Cancún is bathed by the waters of the Caribbean Sea. Just offshore is the Great Mayan Reef, which provides Cancún's visitors some of the best diving experiences in Mexico. You can snorkel straight from the shore at Playa Tortugas to discover colorful species of local fish and marine plant life. Take one of the many tours offered by Cancún's dive centers to swim with dolphins at Playa Delfines.

You'll find a number of archaeological sites in this area – including the “El Rey” ruins right in the heart of Cancun's hotel zone. Visit the Mayan Museum in Cancún to learn about the area's rich cultural history, and to discover why the Mayans were said to have predicted the end of the world for 2012.

From Cancún's port, take the ferry to nearby Isla Mujeres: an island less influenced by modern Cancún tourism. Here, you can visit “El Garrafón” Natural Park or relax on one of the island's quiet beaches.

Cancun's location keeps the weather warm during winter, making it most popular between December and April. The summer months can be very hot and the rainy season begins in early autumn – so it's not the ideal time to visit.

✦ “EL GARRAFÓN” NATURAL REEF PARK.

“El Garrafón” Natural Reef Park is well known all over the world for its astonishing reefs and cliffs right in front of the turquoise waters of the Mexican Caribbean Sea. At just 25 minutes away from Cancún, in the beautiful island of Isla Mujeres, this reef park offers recreative activities such as snorkeling, kayaking, zip-line and tours through the island; and relaxation activities such as Mayan sauna – “temazcal” –, panoramic pool and lounge chairs.

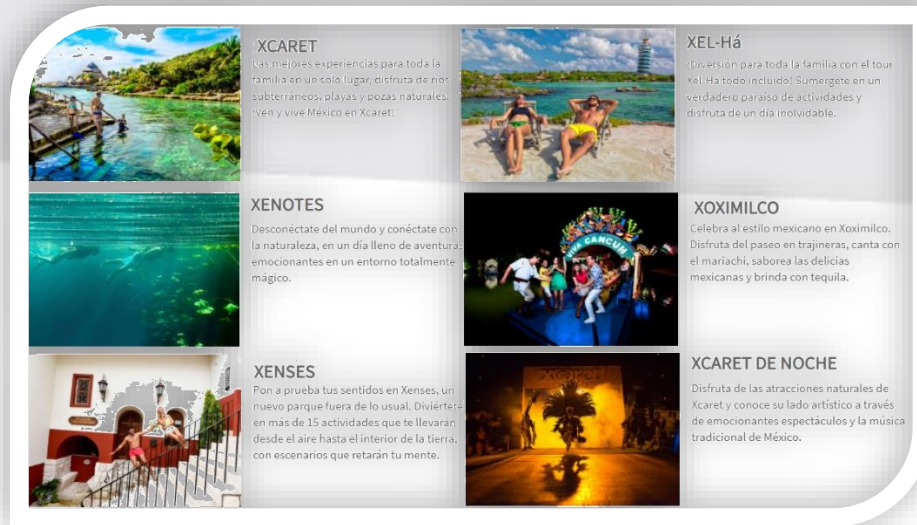
✦ XCARET RIVIERA MAYA.

Xcaret Riviera Maya is a natural park with more than 50 attractions for all ages, perfect for the whole family. Here you can swim in underground rivers, stroll along trails in the middle of the jungle, and tour mysterious caves. Discover new colors at the Butterfly Farm and the mysteries of the seabed at the Coral Reef Aquarium. Get up close to deer, jaguars, flamingos and exotic birds.

At Xcaret Riviera Maya, you'll find several attractions to visit, such as the Mayan vestiges, the Museum of Mexican Popular Art, a classic *henequén* hacienda and the Guadalupe Chapel. Also enjoy Mexican culture with pre-Hispanic dances, *charrería* and the magnificent presentation of Xcaret's spectacle: “México Espectacular” – with more than 300 artists on stage.

At Xcaret Riviera Maya there is a wide variety of restaurants to choose from. And for your greater comfort, they have rest areas, dressing rooms, showers and toilets – all located in different areas of the park.

✧ CANCÚN'S INTERACTIVE AQUARIUM.



Cancún's Interactive Aquarium, in the heart of Cancún, offers a series of participatory activities both inside and outside. Located in the famous shopping center "La Isla", the aquarium is known for its interesting activities, which distinguish it from most traditional aquariums. Cancún's Interactive Aquarium is an adventure that the whole family can enjoy, whether you want to get wet or not. Begin your visit by viewing the 13 tanks on display. You can see rays, eels and clown fish up close.

Each tank is designed to replicate the natural environments of the species that live within them, and together they hold nearly 106 cubic meters

(28,000 gallons) of water. See fish found only on the local coral reef – such as piranha and scorpionfish – as well as those from more distant waters.

ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS.

✧ TULUM

If you like the indigenous heritage of Mexico, this city has the only archaeological site within a beach in the country. In ancient times it had the name of Zamá – which means “sunrise” – but the current name, Tulum, means “enclosure” or “wall”. For the ancient Mayans, this city was the main center of maritime and land trade in the area. Nowadays it captivates everyone who visits it. This Mayan city was built on a cliff from where the turquoise tones of the Caribbean Sea can be appreciated in all its splendor. Another of the most popular activities in Tulum is visiting its “cenotes” – sinkholes – for a swim or snorkeling. Some of the most recommended are the following:
